The **Risk Systems and Data Manager/Analyst** position is an integral component of Sompo International's Enterprise Risk Management framework, helping the Company to assess its global risk accumulations by process management of the core risk systems for the global group. The role sits within the Chief Risk Office and helps create systems platforms applying knowledge of risk analytics and computer systems programs, including PL/SQL, to support, and evolve our modeling efforts and user experiences. The position reports to the SVP, Head of Operational Risk & Reporting and will be located in New York City.

Responsibilities include:

Risk Process Management

- Interface with IT on developing internal computer systems for acquisition, aggregation, and storage of data for our Company needs in terms of data warehousing, access, control, interrogation, and reporting
- Maintaining and supporting our risk analytics computer tools and availability as a liaison between our Business and Information Technology groups
- Refining the efficiency and accuracy of our computer generated risk analysis and data measurement
- Serving as the technical liaison between our IT personnel and our end uses to capture feedback and business requirements for improvement of user experience within our SQL servers

Risk Analytics

- Designing, developing, and deploying new exposure accumulation and risk analytical tools for our Underwriting and Modeling units
- Developing of aggregation techniques and models for non-modeled perils or lines of business
- Defining potential or actual areas of non-Property Cat risk accumulation
- Working to develop and assist with implementation of standards for data quality and data cleansing
- Providing of details of potentially exposed contracts and estimates of loss for modeled classes following an event for input into overall estimation of loss
- Support of underwriters in monitoring and controlling accumulations across their portfolios

Risk Reporting

- Developing and evolving risk dashboards to be presented quarterly to the executive and board risk committees
- Supporting the development of risk management presentations to our regulatory and rating agencies

- Minimum 6 years' experience in a property & casualty (re)insurance environment with preference to analytical, underwriting exposure, operations, IT or operations experience included
- Familiarity with insurance exposure modeling practices
- Excellent statistical/analytical skills to be able to interrogate and interpret data

- Excellent computer skills, particularly with Excel, Access, SQL, and VBA
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to think critically and logically, with attention to detail
- Strong time and project management skills
